FROM THE DESK OF CHAIRMAN

It has come to the notice of the Commission that a concerted effort is being made by a media channel, for the last two days, based on a limited insight into the overall working of the Commission, to distort facts with a malafide and preconceived intent to undermine the reputation of the Commission in the public eye.

- As Chairman of the Staff Selection Commission, it is my duty as Head of 2. the Commission to put the record straight and to inform the candidates and the public at large, that the Staff Selection Commission, which is committed to the principle of merit based selection of candidates and a high standard of integrity in its examination processes, to expedite the process of recruitment of candidates to Group 'B' and Group 'C' posts in the Government of India.
- The News Channel has focused its entire report only on two 3. examinations of the Commission viz. (i) Combined Higher Secondary Level Examination (CHSLE-2015) and (ii) Combined Graduate Level Examination (CGLE-2016). However, it needs to be understood that the Commission is tasked with a much larger responsibility of conducting every year, EIGHT examinations. mandated THREE Limited Departmental Competitive Examination and recruitment for Selection Posts in various Departments/ Ministries in the Government of India.
- 4. In the current year 2017-18, the Commission has also conducted TWO non-mandated examinations, viz. (i) Recruitment of Constables (Executives) in Delhi Police Examination 2016 and (ii) Recruitment of Scientific Assistants in India Meteorological Department and would also conduct the examination for recruitment of Constables (GD) in CAPFs, NIA & SSF and Rifleman (GD) in Assam Rifles-2017.

- 5. It would be necessary to mention that the number of registered candidates for various examinations conducted by the Commission has gone up exponentially from 9.94 lakh in 2008-09 to 2.34 crore during 2016-17.
- 6. In the given context, with regard to the first issue raised by the Media Channel regarding CHSLE 2015, the correct factual position is as follows:

CHSLE 2015 was conducted for 69,96,708 candidates in three stages, namely, Tier-I, Tier-II and Skill Test / Document Verification. 30,44,455 candidates actually sat in the examination. The Tier-I examination was conducted in November—December 2015 and the result was declared on 29.7.2016. Thereafter, Tier-II of the examination was conducted on 18.9.2016 and the result was declared on 29.12.2016. Subsequently, the Skill Test for successful candidates was conducted and the result declared on 30.6.2017. The Document Verification of the shortlisted successful candidates was conducted in July 2017 and the final result of the CHSLE 2015 was declared on 28.8.2017 for 9194 candidates. The dossiers of 8900 successful candidates have already been sent in September-October 2017 to the respective User Departments and for the remaining 294 candidates, the dossiers are being duly verified in consultation with Central Forensic Laboratories. It is for the User Departments concerned to expedite the issuance of the appointment letters to the nominated candidates.

- 7. With regard to the second issue highlighted by the Media Channel i.e. CGLE 2016, the correct position is as under: The said examination was held in August-September 2016 (Tier-I). The examination was conducted in four Tiers and the final result was declared on 05.08.2017 in which 10,661 candidates were declared as successful. Dossiers of more than 9500 candidates have already been sent to the User Departments and the remaining dossiers are in the process of being sent.
- 8. It may be pertinent to note that in Tier-III of the said examination (CGLE-2016), while 98.54% candidates strictly followed the mandatory instructions of the examination, 1.46% (i.e. 484) candidates violated the mandatory instructions and were assigned 'zero' marks in strict conformity with the rule position. Some of these defaulting candidates approached the CAT and got relief for having their answer books evaluated but this relief was ordered by

CAT after the declaration of the result of the said Examination by which time, the Commission had recommended successful candidates against all reported vacancies.

- To protect the sanctity of the rule position and the interest of the bona 9. fide successful candidates at large, (some of whom could be replaced by these defaulting candidates in the event of a revision of result), the Commission in consonance with the laid down procedure, approached Government in Department of Personnel & Training (DoP&T) and Department of Legal Affairs (DoLA), in the month of December 2017 itself seeking permission to file an appeal against the aforesaid Order of CAT. After legal scrutiny, the Government has found it to be a fit case for being challenged in appeal before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and if required the Commission would also move the Hon'ble Apex Court. With this position becoming clear. the Commission will file an appeal in the Hon'ble High Court in the last week of January 2018, and simultaneously inform the User Departments to issue the appointment letters to the bona fide nominated candidates with the condition that their appointment will be subject to the final outcome of the appeal. The appointment letters in all probability would be issued by the User Departments concerned to the successful bona fide candidates in the month of February 2018 itself. However, it is unfortunate that this unwarranted delay has taken place due to the defaulting candidates going in litigation against the mandatory rule position of the Commission at the cost of the bona fide successful candidates.
- 10. With regard to the overall operations of the Staff Selection Commission, the Commission has since January 2016, conducted EIGHTEEN (18) All India Open Competitive Examinations and NINE (09) Examinations for recruitment to Selection Posts for a total of 3,37,65,415 candidates. The results of FIFTEEN (15) examinations have already been declared and 88,537 candidates have been recommended for appointment to the User Departments concerned. The results of the remaining TWELVE (12) examinations are to be declared within the next six months i.e. from January to July 2018. Comprehensive details in this regard are given in the enclosed Statement. From a reading of the said statement, it can be observed that the Commission has been progressively reducing the time period for the conduct of the examinations from more than one year to less than six months. In fact,

in the last three examinations viz. (i) Multi Tasking (Non-Technical) Staff Examination (ii) Examination for Recruitment of Scientific Assistant in India Meteorological Department, (iii) Recruitment of Constables (Executives) in Delhi Police Examination, the results would be declared within a record time of three to five months only.

11. The total nominations for recruitment made by the Commission, during the last three years, i.e. 2015-16 to 2017-18, is given in the Table below:

12. The Commission functions in a transparent manner, giving due emphasis in its operations to merit based selection of candidates without compromising on the integrity of examination process. The Commission is committed to expediting the process of recruitment of candidates to various Group 'B' and Group 'C' posts in the Government of India. This information is being hosted by the Commission in the public domain, in the larger public interest, to give the candidates a correct perspective into the operations of the Commission.
